Important: Only official transportation may be used to reach the start, the use of private vehicles is prohibited.

Categories:

According to the Rules (15.2): W19, M19, W21, M21, W35, M40, W45, M50, W55, M60, W65, M70

Change of category and starting group:

Change of category and starting group can be made until 10.00 of the day before competition.

Ranking:

Individual for each category and each competition, team ranking for each category for the two classics. Competitors at 1.-3. places will be awarded with medals and certificates.

Terrain

The competition areas are characterized by gently rolling hills, sandy soil, and a mix of pine and broadleaf forests. The landscape features numerous deep ravines, small valleys, occasional marshes, and forest clearings.

Marking devices:

SportIdent system (not SIAC) will be used, control numbers and bands will be written on the SI unit.

Control flags:

- 3.5 MHz band: standard 30x30 cm 3-sided white and orange flag at all controls
- 144 MHz band: 30x30 cm 3-sided white and orange flag with a blue vertical stripe at all controls
- Sprint: 30x30 cm 3-sided white and orange flag at S (spectator) and B (beacon) controls, red/white striped SI stand (no flag) at all other controls.
- Foxoring: 30x30 cm 3-sided white and orange flag at B (beacon) control, red/white striped SI stand (no flag) at all other controls.



Sprint (18 August 2025)

IMPORTANT: Birštonas City Park, located in the vicinity of the Eglė Sanatorium, is an embargoed area until the end of the sprint competition. Any additional scouting or walking within this area will be considered a violation of fair play rules. Until the sprint competition, participants may use only the main roads to access and leave the sanatorium.

You can familiarize with embargoed areas which will be used for competitions here.
