- In order to promote the sport both inside and outside of the Nordic countries open class competitor David Williams will compete in M60 class, without possibility to Nordic Champion title.

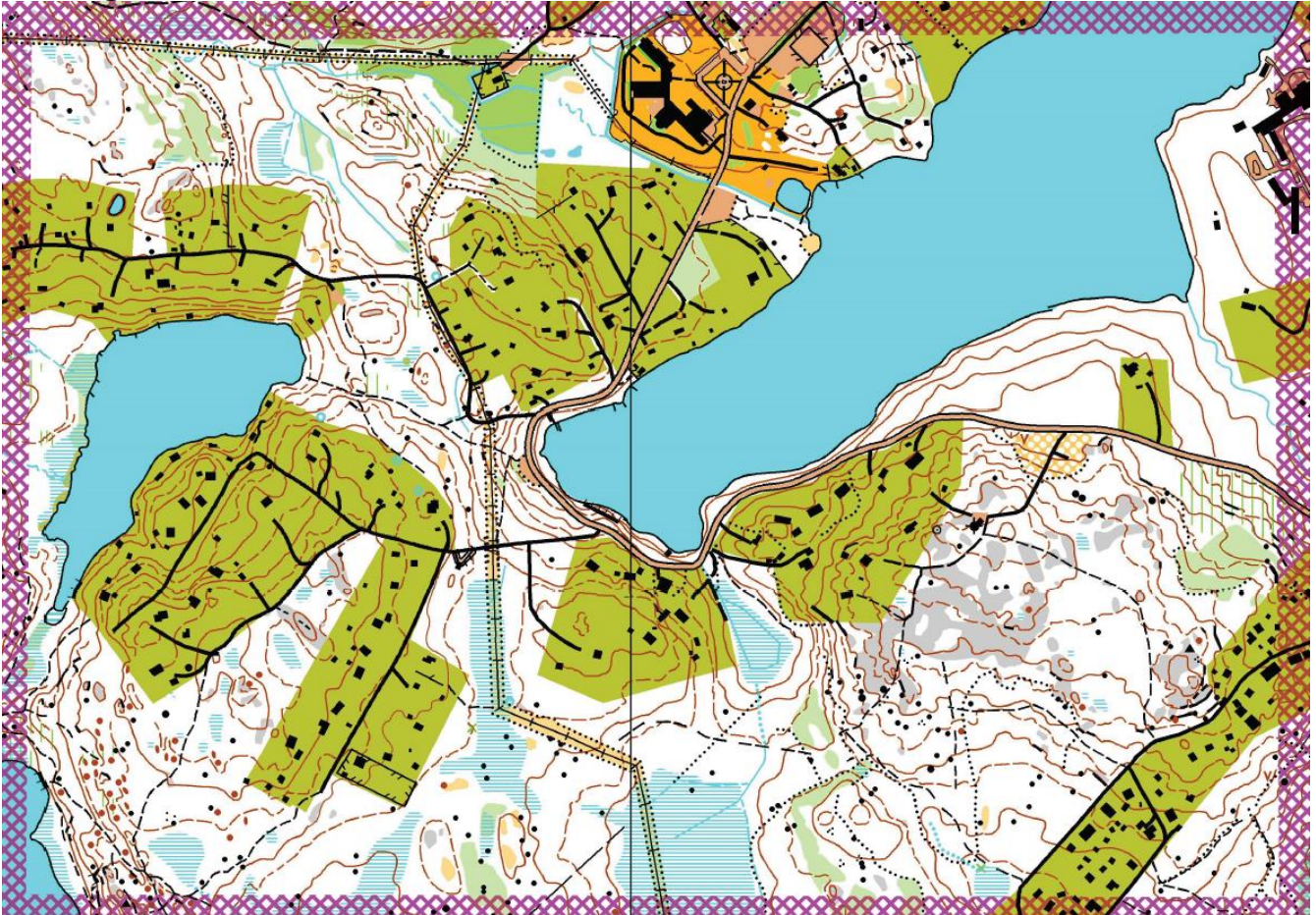
Friday, July 28th, 2023

Sprint training 12:30-14:30, 1 fox per frequency. Departure to sprint competition at 15:30.

Classics 3.5 MHz and 144 MHz training 19:00-21:00, 2 foxes + beacon per band.

Training events orienteering flags and SportIdent controls are placed same way as in competition.

Training area



Information for the Sprint competition

- The transmitters are marked with a 15x15 cm orienteering flag, 30-50 cm above ground.
- Registration device: SportIdent. Controls are marked 1-5, S, 1F-5F and B.
- Starting and finish corridor marked by continuous red/white strip on both sides of corridor.
- The start, finish, spectator beacon and finish beacon are marked on the map.
- Time limit: 60 minutes.
- Map: A4 landscape format, in scale 1:5 000, waterproof.
- The maps are handed out to competitors 2 minutes before each individual start.
- The time for preparation and warm-up at the start is at least 45 minutes.
- Competitors enter the pre-start area 4 minutes before their start.
- There is no formal seeding procedure for the random start list.

- Antenna: Vertical 5 m and three ground planes 3 m each
- Transmit power: 0.5 W
- Foxes 1-5 (slow): 3510 kHz
- Spectator beacon (S): 3540 kHz
- Foxes 1F-5F (fast): 3570 kHz
- Finish beacon (MO): 3600 kHz

Information for the 3.5 MHz and 144 MHz competition, July 29th & 30th, 2023

- Five hidden transmitters.
- Each transmitter sends for 1 minute in 5-minute cycles.
- Each transmitter is marked with a 15x15 cm orienteering flag, 50-100 cm above ground.
- Registration device: SportIdent. Controls are marked 1-5 and B.
- Starting and finish corridor marked by continuous red/white strip on both sides of corridor.
- The start, finish and finish beacon are marked on the map.
- Exclusion circles for start (750m) and for finish beacon (400 m) are marked with dashed line on the map.
- Time limit: 150 minutes.
- Map: A4 landscape format, in scale 1:10 000, waterproof.
- The maps are handed out to competitors 10 minutes before each individual start.
- The time for preparation and warm-up at the start is at least 45 minutes.
- Competitors enter the pre-start area 10 minutes before their start.
- There is no formal seeding procedure for the random start list.

Technical information for 3.5 MHz

- Antenna: Vertical 7 m and three ground planes 6 m each
- Transmit power: 3 W
- Foxes 1-5: 3579 kHz
- Finish beacon (MO): 3520 kHz

Technical information for 144 MHz

- Antenna: Crossed dipole 2.5m above ground
- Transmit power: 0.7 W
- Foxes 1-5: 144.763 MHz
- Finish beacon (MO): 144.503 MHz
